Social change and identity during Perestroika in Mongolia

Individuals become members of the society through evaluating and estimating themselves and the others, social life and fashion, as well as other processes going on.

This research is relevant to anyone interested in how communist societies functioned, how certain type of personality was formed and in what way people accepted, recognized and interpreted state ideology. In this presentation we aim to analyze how the changes in politics, society and economy that had been happening in Mongolia since the middle of 1980s till the beginning of the 1990s, impacted individual and collective identities of Mongolian people.

We will try to depict and analyze collective and individual behavioral patterns by **interpreting the data on the names Mongolian people chose for their newborns during Perestroika**. Since 1988 and especially in 1990 there occurred to be a rapid increase of names, illustrating reconsideration of Mongol history and religion and the raise of national identity.
