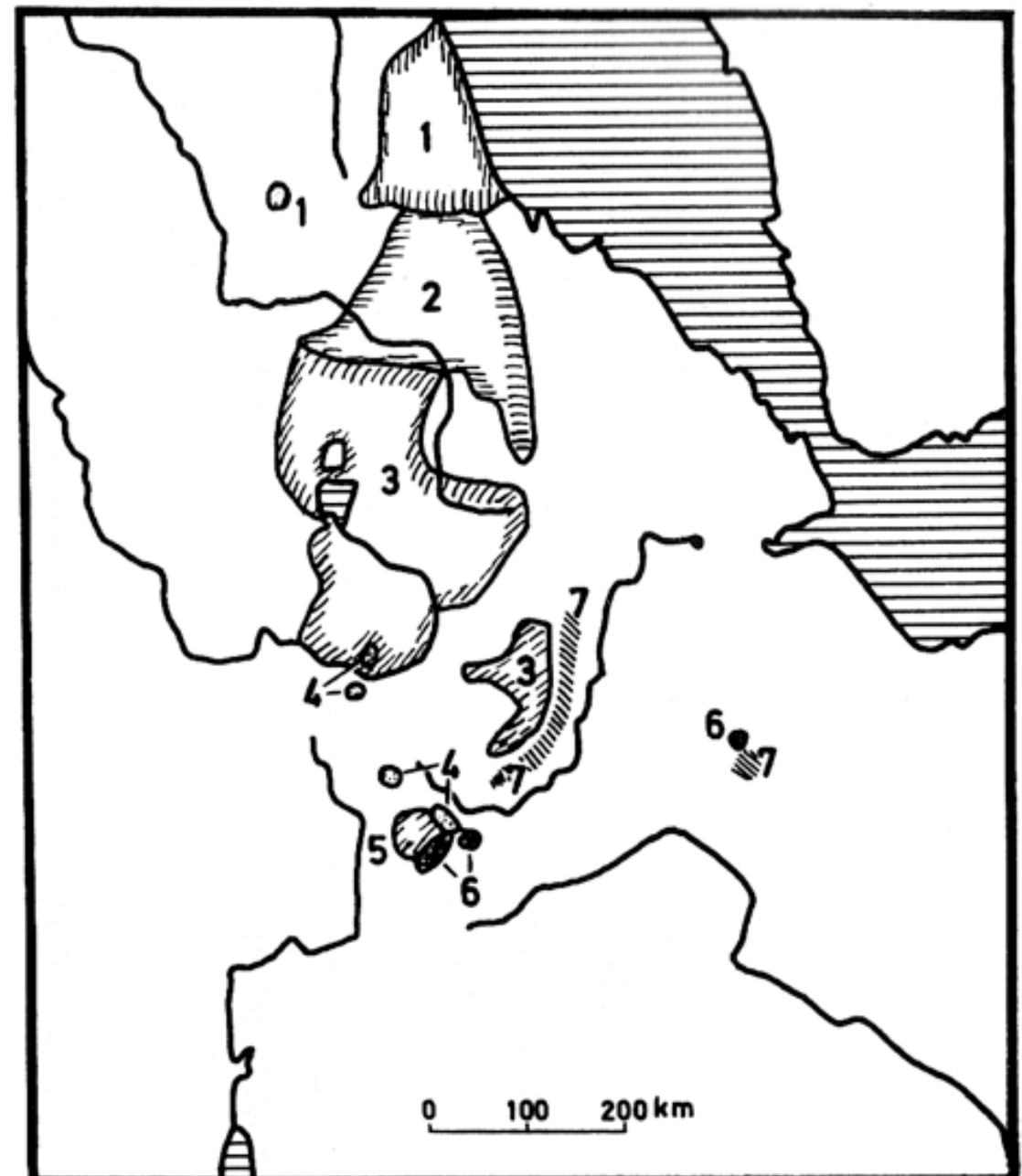
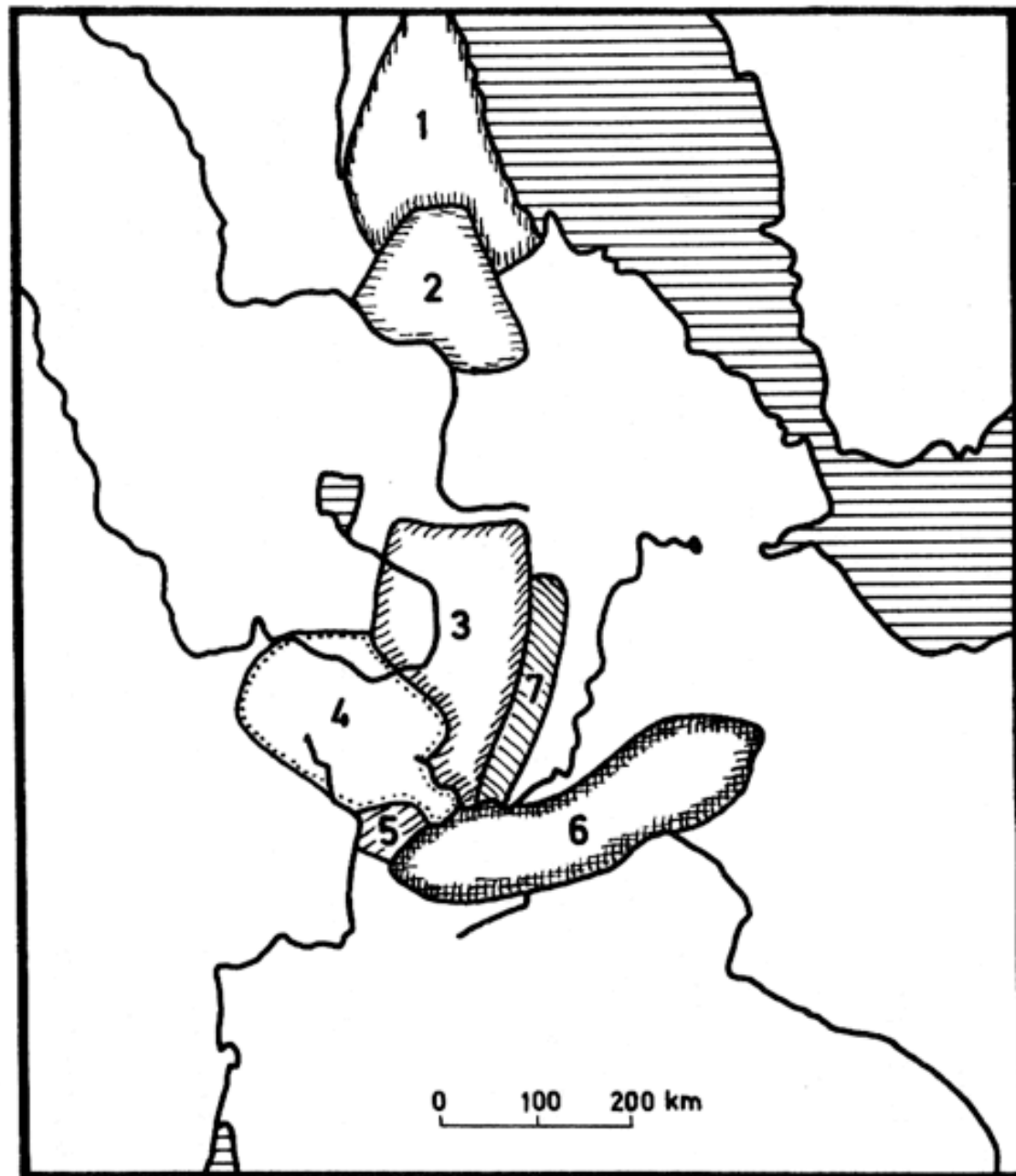


Ruins of Fäqi Däbis mosque (above) and Asbäri (below) in Yifat

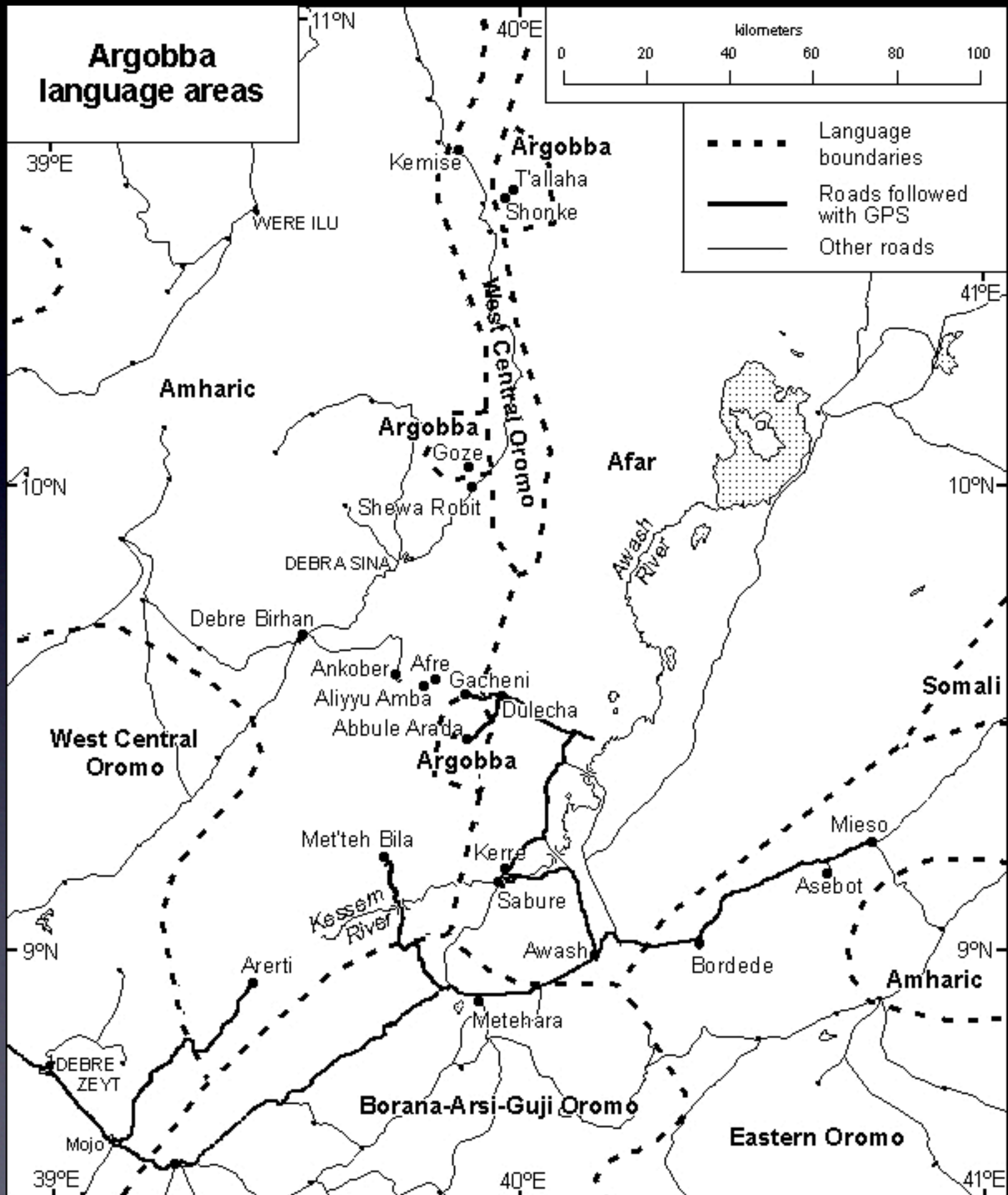

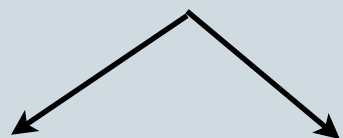

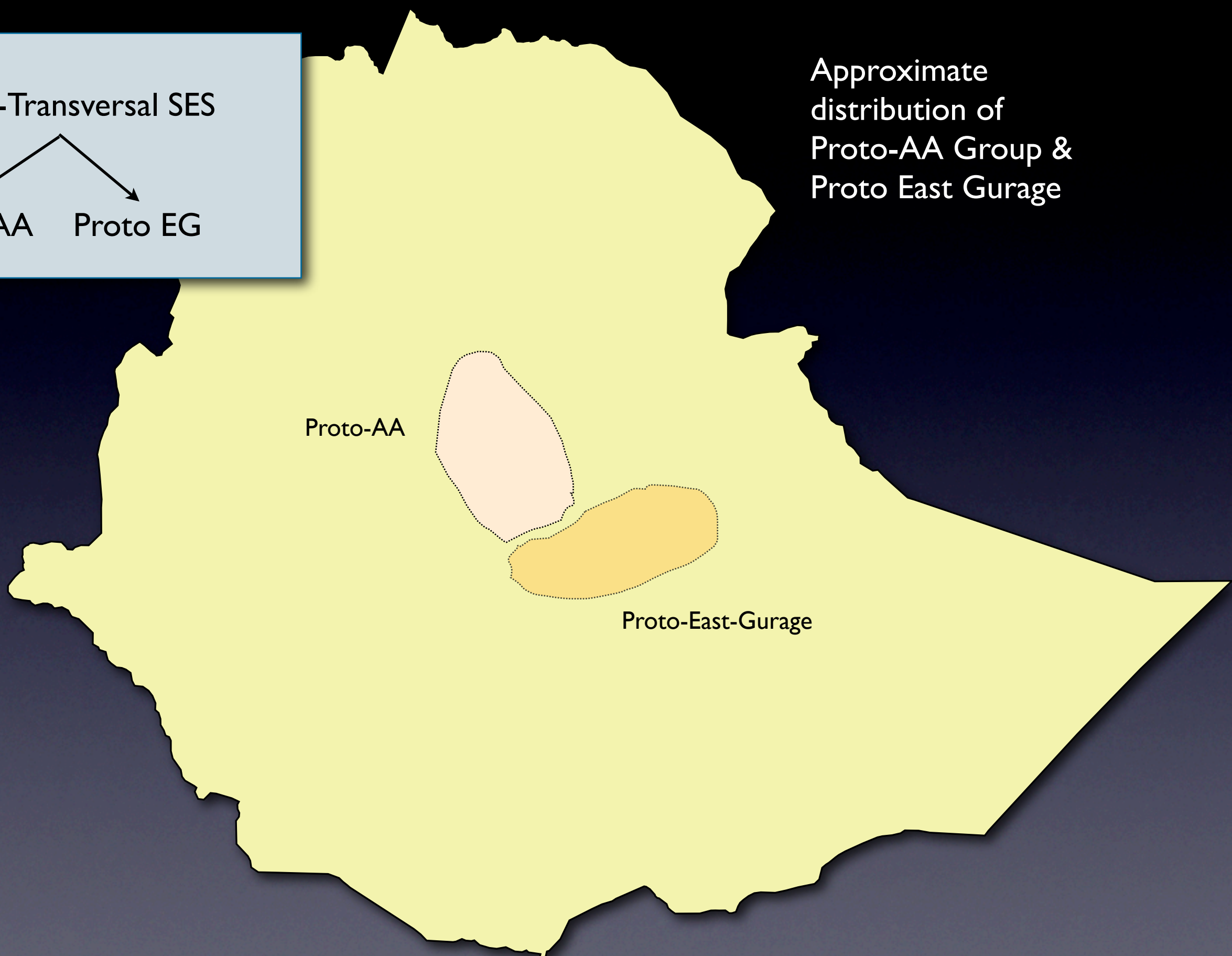

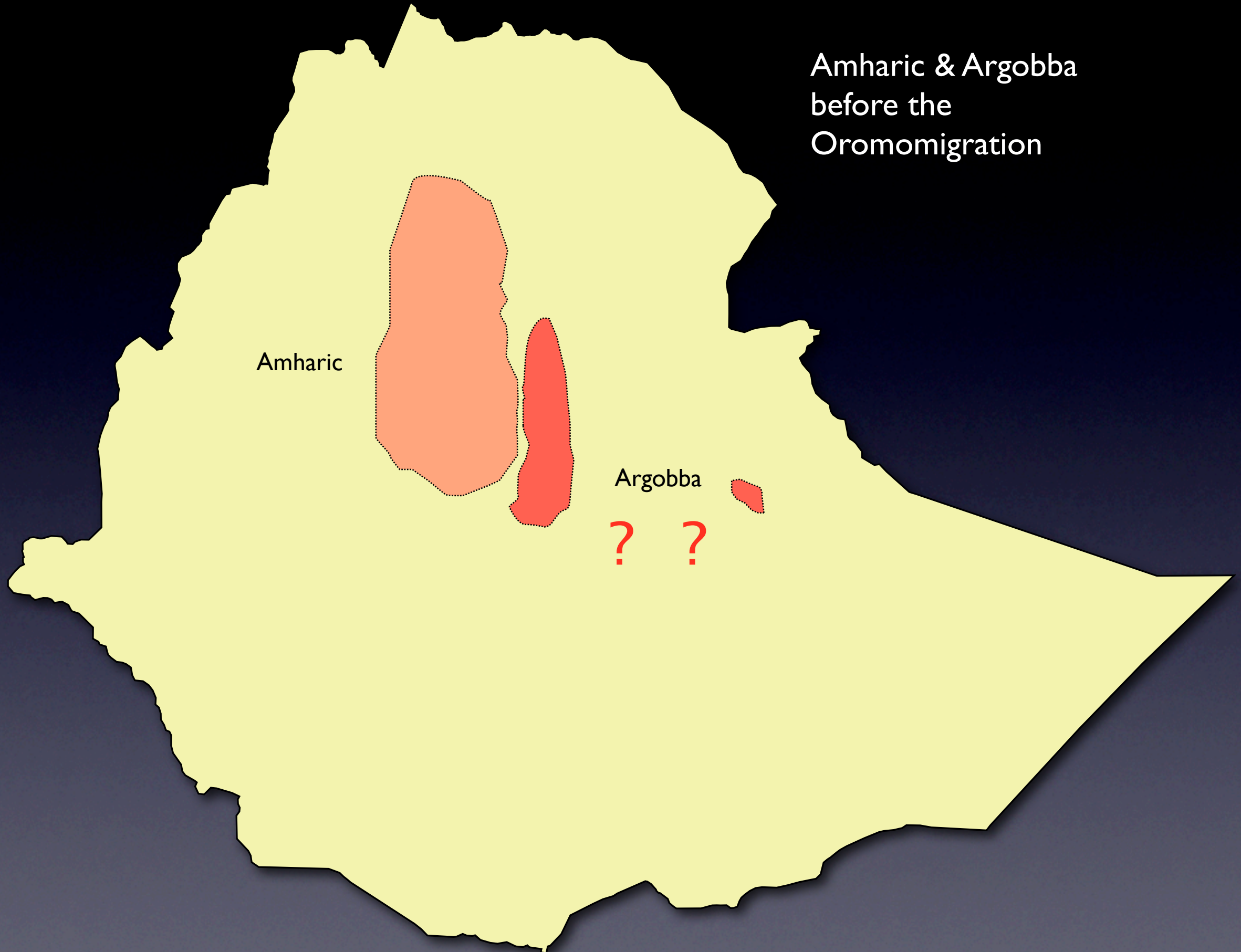
