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Dissertation: “Documentation of N!aqriaxe: Clause linkage”

N!ariaxe displays five different types of clause linkage: complex sentences can be divided into coordinate clauses and subordinate clauses where one of the clauses (the main clause) is modified by one or more subordinate clauses that are dependent upon it and introduced by one of the subordinate markers. Subordinate clauses can function as conditional clauses, as purpose clauses, as relative clauses or as general dependent clauses. Depending on their function, they are marked with a specific clause-linkage marker. The presentation discusses the N!aqriaxe clause linkage types and the respective markers involved. Furthermore, it sets apart monoclausal constructions containing more than one verb from bi- or polyclausal constructions. The discussion focuses on methodological problems in the analysis of these clauses and addresses the question whether there are complement clauses in N!aqriaxe.
