The course addresses students and Ph. D. candidates of all subjects as well as voluntary attendants.

For a total of up to 10 student and Ph. D. candidates the DAAD is going to financially support the attendance by partial scholarships (grant for travel, residence and course costs). You have to assume the risk of excess. For voluntary attendants the course is offered only with costs (dues on request).

The **course** is going to take place in a private building in Mazari Sharif. The attendants who are financially supported by the DAAD will also stay there. As the situation permits, little excursions can be organized on days off lessons.
