**Recent Investigations in the Tawang Valley,
Western Arunachal Pradesh.**

Richard Blurton will present data gathered over several years on the culture of the Tawang valley, located at the tri-junction where India, Bhutan and Tibet meet. He will talk especially about the monastery at Kibnas (reputedly founded in the 13th century) and the chorten at Gorsam.

Richard Blurton is one of three curators for collections from South and Southeast Asia at the British Museum . His publications include 'Hindu Art' (1992), 'Tibetan Legacy. Paintings from the Hahn Kwang-ho Collection' (co-author 2003) and 'Bengali Myths' (2006).
